The Unit Restriction Proposal Task Force met on Thursday October 13, 2016. After reviewing and discussing data provided by Michele Pena and Dr. Janet Fulks, we came to the conclusion that placing unit restrictions on students during early registration would not significantly affect the number of students on waitlists. Therefore, we I rescind the proposal at this time.

Secondly, the task force discussed a 'glitch' in Banner that may significantly influence waitlists: Michelle Pena mentioned that Banner allows BC students to get on multiple waitlists for the <u>same</u> course. This 'glitch' can be easily be remedied at the district office by a simple 'click of a box'. Therefore, Michelle Pena will forward the task force's request to remove the ability for students to sit on multiple waitlists for the same course.
