

Bakersfield College Call for Nominations:

Faculty Leadership in Guided Pathways Academic Year 2021-22

The Bakersfield College Guided Pathways Implementation Team (GPIT) invite faculty leaders in the College's 10 Learning & Career Pathway Completion Coaching Communities to provide leadership and direction for their respective meta-major pathways.

Eligibility

- Any full time faculty member (tenure not required) interested in advancing the work of their Learning & Career Pathway (LCP) Completion Community
- One Guided Pathways Faculty Lead per LCP. Additional faculty lead considered on a case-by-case basis and determined by the administrative lead of the LCP

Responsibilities

- Attend Guided Pathways Implementation Team meetings
- Partner with the Learning & Career Pathway (LCP) administrative lead to develop a work plan and meeting schedule for the academic year
- Co-lead all LCP Completion Community meetings in coordination with the administrative Lead (bi-weekly or monthly, depending on Completion Community)
- In collaboration with the administrative lead organize and lead pathway calling campaigns at within the Student Information Desk (SID) to support ongoing enrollment and retention efforts.
- Develop and oversee program-specific recognition of students for completion of momentum points
- Serve as the communication liaison for the Guided Pathways Implementation Team
- Develop and disseminate guided pathways information to Completion Community and department in departmental meetings
- Serve as a liaison for all disciplines within the LCP

Accountability

- The Guided Pathways Implementation Team will coordinate directly with the administrative Lead for each LCP to monitor the work and evaluate deliverables

Compensation

- Selected faculty leaders will be paid a stipend not to exceed \$3150 (equivalent to 0.2 reassigned time)

Process for Consideration

- Faculty self-nominate for consideration to the perspective LCP administrative Lead. Applicants should provide a brief vision statement indicating what the applicant would like to accomplish for his/her respective pathway through this leadership role.
- The perspective administrative Lead will review faculty applications, approve appropriately, and forward names to the Guided Pathways Implementation Team leads
- The Guided Pathways Implementation Team will submit names of faculty lead recommendations to Academic Senate for approval
- All senate approved faculty leads will sign a special compensation agreement
