- The 2022-23 Program Review Assessment Report has been approved & sent to PRC.
 - After the Accreditation Mid-Term Report team pointed out a lack of evidence showcasing improvements based on assessment, the committee has decided to add a new section to the Assessment Report called Revise, asking for examples of course or program improvements or changes based on past data.
 - We are also revising our Handbook and our acronym (PARR) to reflect this clarification.
