## **Trending Issues**

- 1. Trending book order issues:
  - a. Book refunds are problematic in processing and taking a long time to get refunds back in the the hands of the students. Supposed to take 3-7 days.
  - b. Student book orders that contain multiple items are being mailed in separate boxes with different order numbers without notifying students.
  - c. Strange occurrence: eCampus replaced some original book orders with a different textbook that eCampus chose. We are investigating this phenomenon so it doesn't happen again. Please inform BAC if this happened to you!
  - d. eCampus incurred late-fees by missing publisher ordering deadlines and then imposed these fees on students. In some cases, eCampus is now markup some books up to 60% higher than the original price of the textbook. Please inform BAC if you find your book is being sold higher than usual.
