January 26 meeting

Rising Scholars Program

The Admin Co-chair, Dean McCrow announced that the CCC State Chancellor will be visiting our RSP and some area prisons on 3/1/2024 to learn more about the RSP.

BC Campus Police Establishment

- I. Members discussed the suggestion to create a campus police department and listened to the Executive Director of campus safety, Mr Grubbs, who explained his proposal and took questions from members.
- II. Some members expressed concerns that that the permanent presence of armed police officers on our campus will leave some segments of our community feeling unsafe, creating a campus community that is neither equitable/inclusive, nor safe for ALL members, contrary to our college values.
- III. Members expressed a willingness to advocate for more funding for campus safety officers, but Mr. Grubbs declined noting that the presence of sworn officers is the solution.
- IV. Members agreed to continue the police department discussion during the next meeting.

February 9, 2024 Meeting

1. EODAC Charge

The review of the committee charge was completed and alignment with accreditation done. Charge will be put in the new format and submitted to the AS on or before its 2/28 meeting.

2. Committee Goals for 2023/2024

Members discussed and voted to focus the committee's work for 2023/24 on the following 3 goals:

Goal 1: Increase student awareness of and access to all student services offered by Bakersfield College by establishing the "**Renegade Success" Magazine**. Recommending and promoting practices that enhance student success and equity is part of the charge of EODAC.

Goal 2: Enhance Professional Development and Institutional Equity through Strategic Engagement in Pathways to Equity Initiatives. Promoting professional development on DEIA and driving equity-focused changes at BC and KCCD is part of the EODAC charge.

Goal 3: Ensure Campus Safety &/Police Department Aligns to DEIA

- I. The committee continued the conversation around equitable campus safety and the proposal to form a campus police department. Members raised the following concerns:
 - i) that campus safety officers are classified staff and those classified staff positions may be reduced and/or eliminated if a campus police department is formed.
 - ii) that the permanent placement of sworn officers on campus will be a failure by BC & the district to recognize the emotional and mental violence that members of our Black and Brown community suffer when they have to deal with armed police.
- II. The committee voted to task EODAC to collaborate with the College Safety Department and other stakeholders to ensure that campus safety and/or the establishment and operation of a College Police Department embodies the principles of diversity, equity, inclusion, and accessibility.
