## Updates

**Special Election for Vacancies Proposal** – Recommendation from AS Executive Board: Keep vacancies open and hold election during next regular election (Spring 2026) per executive board majority interpretation of C&Bs as vacancies have occurred in the past and are not an unanticipated circumstance.

**Cerro Coso Resolution** – Email from Chancellor regarding a pause on installations in instructional spaces while waiting for BP/AP. At BC, work and installation may continue as planned in purely non-instructional spaces.

**Bookstore Concerns** – Districtwide concerns with the bookstore raised. Chancellor Bloomberg will review the current contract and seek faculty input for next steps and future partnerships.

**Standing Committee Appointments for 25-26** – Draft of appointments will be shared with Executive Board members via email so co-chairs may reach out to departments/areas without representation. The form close during summer and then reopen in the fall after the Fall Call goes out.

**Catalog start semester** – Align catalog year with academic calendar. The next catalog year will be Summer 25-Summer 26. The following catalog year will be Fall 26-Summer 27, with a fall start for subsequent years. The catalog rights page in the catalog will need to be reviewed and revised for the 26-27 catalog year.

**Elumen Updates** – eLumen, in addition to partnering with Instructure for Insights for Canvas Outcomes, is now partnering with Coursedog for curriculum, catalog, and scheduling needs. More information to come.
