AB 928 (Cal-GETC) Updates

AB 1111 (Common Course Numbering) Updates

Phase I courses and impacted ADTs are all revised.

Phase II Part A courses need to be student-facing by Fall 2026. Phase II Part B and Phase III courses need to be student-facing by Fall 2027.
