

# Safety Advisory Committee Report to Academic Senate

October 1, 2025 (Committee Meeting Date September 10, 2025)

## Announcements:

- Questions have come up if vaping is allowed on campus. Vaping is not allowed on campus and College Safety will work to get signs made to clearly state so.
- The Board approved a police department on campus. This is in progress and will take approximately one year for implementation.
- Student housing is approximately 40 percent complete. The new Agriculture building and Student housing is planned to be open by Fall 2026.

## Completed Items:

- Permanent campus wide cameras in common areas were installed over the summer.

## Upcoming Items:

- Interior Campus Vehicular Safety
  - A pre-bid vendor meeting for the gates was completed on September 9<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Bids are due from vendors by the end of September.
  - The bollards project is planned to be completed if there is enough funds left over from the gate project.
- Clearly Compliance is underway with Carlos Rios compiling the report to be ready for October 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Campus Sworn Officers Update: See announcement above. The main role will be to protect our staff and students and will integrate into our campus family.
- Emergency Response Procedures: College Safety met on March 11<sup>th</sup>, 2025 with all college presidents and reviewed needed security updates on campuses.
