

Rationale for Proposal of Technology Innovation and Collaboration Committee (TICC)

For Review at the Academic Senate October 15th Regular Meeting

There was a lack of engagement, within the ISIT committee, over the 2024-25 academic year. Administration has introduced the idea of developing a new technology committee

- Administrators noted that only a handful of committee members participated in the technology requests rankings, an important function of the ISIT committee.
- ISIT Website has not been maintained over the past year
- ISIT Faculty Co-Chair position remains vacant
- VPI and IT Director would like to see the dissolution of ISIT with a new technology committee to take its place

A rebranding or charge update may be a faster, smoother process than dissolving one committee and building a similar one in its place.
