Legislative Updates

Tier 1 - impacts to CCCs with CCCCO guidance

AB 992 & SB 385: Peace Officers: Clarify Educational requirements based on Modern Policing task force recommendations. Optional to follow ASCCC model curriculum in the development of degree. Changes deadlines to 2031.

SB 640: Public Postsecondary Education: Extends CSU Dual Admissions program to 2037. Requires CCC to participate in specific ways. No new funding.

SB 744: Accrediting Agencies: Ensures California schools will continue to operate as expected in the event the federal government revoked accreditation until 2030.

AB 88 & SB 67: Student Financial Aid: Extend Calgrant and Middle Class Scholarship Program to more populations. Guidance coming.

AB 313: Student Financial Aid: Allows deadlines to postponed without so many steps.

AB 42: CalWORKS and CalFresh: Scholarships will not count towards income limits for CalWorks or CalFresh

SB 271: Public Postsecondary Education: Lists specific responsibilities for Basic Needs Centers regarding students with dependents.

AB 287: Elections: Polling places, including schools, need to have adequate parking and comply with accessibility requirements.

AB 648: Community Colleges Housing: Lists specific requirements for CCC Housing to qualify for local zoning exemptions.

AB 893: Housing Development Projects: Include CCC Housing

Ab 1028: Temporary Employees: Districts should comply with procedures in Collective Bargaining Unit agreements.

SB 241: Personnel Qualifications: People should be qualified for the job they are hired for.

AB 268: State Holidays: Optional observance of Diwali

AB 1098: California Education Interagency Council (CEIC): Creates a new body by June 2026.

SB 391: Data request fee policy: Allows CCCCO to charge for compiling complex data.

SB 639: CEIC: Aligns California Career Technical Education Grant (CTEG) with CEIC.

SB 707: Modernizing Brown Act: Extends and clarifies provisions about teleconference.

SB 619: Public Postsecondary Education: Update state references from IGETC to Cal-GETC and Foster and Kinship Care Provider to Resource Family. Districts and colleges should update materials as well.

AB 728: Pupil and Student Safety: Student ID cards must have certain resources numbers printed on them by Fall 2026.

SB 98: Immigration Enforcement Notification: Districts and colleges are to provide training and guidance on how to comply.

SB 580: Immigration Enforcement Policies: Districts and colleges should comply with policies.

SB 670: Immigrant Integration: Districts and colleges should comply with policies.

AB 323: Strong Workforce Preparation: Allows CCCs to use funds to support paid work-based learning opportunities.
