Questions for the Union:

- What is the Union's position on RSI for hybrid classes?
- Will class sizes be reduced from 45 to 35 or 30 students due to the workload associated with RSI?

Answers from the Union:

- The union's position on RSI for hybrid classes is that the union is not the arbiter of RSI. While the union may not agree with the current policy of RSI towards hybrid classes, the union does not possess the authority to change the policy.
- Although the previous president (Jerry Fliger) indicated that it was his goal to reduce class sizes, it does not appear that the current administration will be reducing class sizes. Some departments have reduced online classes from 64 to 45, but there is no indication that class sizes will be reduced any further.
