- Members are invited for further discussion or suggestions regarding the composition of the charge.
- The framework may evolve in time.

Online Teaching Guidelines [Andrasian-Jones, Commiso, Rocky]

Alex Rocky and Matt Andrasian-Jones presented the revisions to the Online Teaching Guidelines and explained the purpose. Grace Commiso answered questions regarding the presentation.

Highlights:
