## Legislative Updates

The ASCCC is currently monitoring **109 Tier 1** bills that were either introduced in 2026 or are still active from 2025. Tier 1 bills will most likely have a direct impact on the California Community Colleges. A full Legislative Matrix and a list of all Tier 1 bills can be found by visiting the [State Relations page on our website](#). April 24 was the deadline for policy committees to hear and advance bills with fiscal impacts to the appropriations committees. Any fiscal bill not heard by a policy committee by this date will not move forward this year.

### **Priority Legislation Updates this week**

- [AB 1730 \(Fong\)](#) This bill amended to appropriate \$100,000,000 for the 2026–27 fiscal year from the General Fund to the California Community Colleges to fund external resolution services for civil rights compliance provided by the managing entity.
- [AB 1858 \(Lowenthal\)](#) This bill was amended to specify that Associates Degrees awarded by CSU and a partnering institution must have no cost to the student.
- [AB 2392 \(Fong\)](#) This bill was amended to require the California Community Colleges and the California State University, and request the University of California, to take several steps before and during the implementation of generative artificial intelligence (GenAI) systems, including convening a joint working group to develop recommendations on procurement standards and training by January 1, 2028, and providing training to students, faculty, and staff; it further requires ongoing annual review and updates to that training, maintenance of records documenting completed trainings, and, until formal procurement standards are adopted, submission of a written report to the Legislature detailing the evaluation and selection process used prior to entering into any GenAI system contract.
- [AB 2466 \(Fong\)](#) This bill was amended to extend the deadline by one year for the Chancellor's Office to revise the policies, regulations, and guidance necessary to provide students, employers, or both, with paid work-based learning opportunities using Strong Workforce funds.

- [AB 2540 \(Stefani\)](#) This bill was amended to move implementation back to 2028 and allow for telehealth to be used for abortion by medication.
- [AB 2694 \(Alvarez\)](#) This bill was amended to refine how community college baccalaureate programs are approved and evaluated by narrowing the prohibition on duplication to programs that are “substantially similar” within a college’s geographic region, allowing exceptions where universities are not serving local students or where unmet regional workforce needs exist, and by revising the consultation and objection process to require focused engagement between the California Community Colleges, California State University, and University of California when similarity concerns arise; the amendments also streamline prior consultation requirements, clarify evidentiary standards for workforce need, and maintain limits and conditions on program approval, enrollment, and funding within the statewide baccalaureate framework
