## Minutes

<p>Approval of 1/29/24 Minutes            Motion to approve: Kristin; seconded: Kim Nickell            All in favor</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">Chairs Report: Grace &amp; Jessica</p> <p>Kimberly Bligh and Jessica made presentations to the Senate and college council about fraud mitigation. Todd Coston will now be taking over as lead on fraudulent students. On February 5<sup>th</sup>, the district launched the use of ID Me to verify student identity when they register.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">Jessica: Before Christmas break, all deans were tasked with identifying fraudulent students in their class enrollments and worked with IT to develop an algorithm to identify fraudulent registrations. Findings so far have resulted in 2% false positives. Students identified as fraudulent will be put “on hold” from receiving financial aid but they will be able to keep their seat in class.</p> <p>Think mobile is attempting to identify fraudulent students and will run a test case. We will supply 1000 student registrations in total and half will be legitimate then the results will determine their accuracy. Depending on the results, could consider a contract with them. We may also try a pilot with LexisNexis that is funded by the State Chancellor’s office, and this should run over this year.</p> <p>At the board meeting Jessica attended, the board members voiced concern over the fraudulent registrations and wanted to know what actions we are taking to reduce.
