A guide to viewing CORs

1. Open Chrome or Firefox (use other browsers at your own risk).
2. Use this link or type this into your browser: <https://bakersfield.elumenapp.com>
3. Log in using the same credentials you use when you log into your email or other college apps.

6. From here, go to department and SELECT NONE, and then choose the department where you would like to select a COR.


