3. Enrollment Management Committee

Purpose: Establishes a process for setting enrollment goals, defining actions to meet the goals, and monitors progress toward achieving them. Reports to the College Council and Academic Senate.

4. Safety Advisory Committee

Purpose: To identify health and safety concerns and issues on campus and address them. Inform the college community of new policies and procedures as they relate to health and safety. To develop and maintain current emergency response plans.
