I. Program Vision

The Student Services Program Perks (S.S.P.) aims to build a culture where student participation is the currency of recognition. This initiative recognizes student engagement, encourages academic performance, and promotes leadership by rewarding students with tiered perks based on their contributions to campus life.

II. Official Sticker Colors, Tiers, and Eligibility

Each sticker represents a tier of student engagement and is associated with exclusive perks.

III. Point-Based Tracking System

Participation is the currency of the BCSGA Program. A point-based system will be used to track engagement.

- Red: Executive-Led VIP Series 'Top Tier. Period.'
- Gold: Academic Recognition Events 'Smart Gets Rewarded'

VIII. Enhanced Verification & Visual Identification

A. Dot Printing on Student ID Photos

To enhance the integrity and visibility of the BCSGA S.S.P Program, a color dot representing a student's earned tier will be placed onto the top-right corner of their official Bakersfield College ID photo. This provides a secure, non-removable way to confirm a student's eligibility and tier at events.

This placed dot method will serve as the primary verification strategy. Current KVC Sticker will serve as blue sticker.

B. Event Scanning System

All BCSGA and club-sponsored events will include a simple, doable way of tracking attendance. This includes using digital forms and manual verification by event leads.

These methods are authorized:

- QR Code Sign-In linked to a Microsoft Teams Form (logs name, tier, and event).
- -Barcode/QR Code App Scanning/ have students scan a barcode to check in
- Manual Sign-in Sheets, approved by BCSGA staff or club advisors
