 - o Participation in this event is included in engagement agreement
 - o Let Director Griepsma or Advisor Nicole Alvarez know 72 hours in advance to be excused for an absence from an event
- Importance of showing up to these events: to make sure you are in good standing for your engagement agreement; if you do not participate in one SGA event per semester it will put you in poor standing; good standing puts you in the running to apply for an SOF grant
- Attendance for ICC meetings starts over at the beginning of each semester
- Other delegates can represent club at ICC meeting if appointed representative is unavailable
