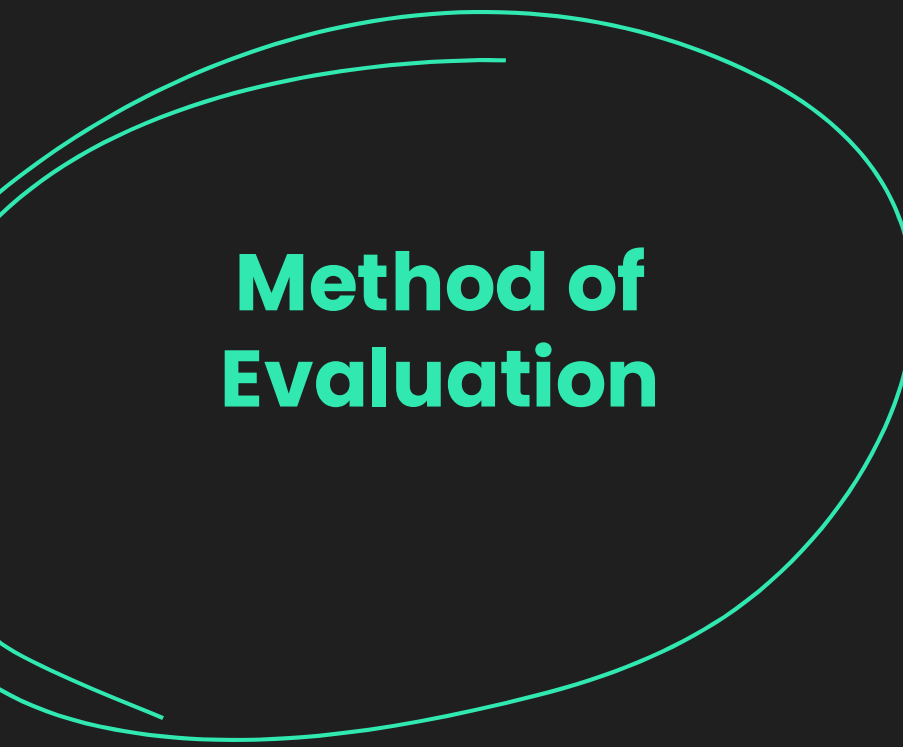
Impact of Attending

Method of Evaluation

Reflection and Feedback

Collect written or verbal reflections from team members about what they learned in leadership, teamwork, and ethical reasoning.

Performance Assessment

Reviewing judges' feedback and team scores from the competition to identify strengths and areas for improvement.
