



## **KHSD and BC 2015 Partnership Goals**

*Updated: January 2015*

- 1. Development of long-term educational plan, 9 – 14, that identifies areas of collaboration and acceleration through the pipeline**
  - a. Multiple measures (assess current practices and improve)
  - b. Senior coursework- Development of 4<sup>th</sup> year math course (initial stages, parallel to Expository Reading and Writing Course (ERWC))
  - c. Summer bridges (designed for particular pathways or needs and assigned in senior Spring term)
  - d. STEM/MESA outreach
  - e. Dual and co-enrollment
  - f. Involvement of community partners
  
- 2. Curricular work and alignment with Common Core and Smarter Balance**
  - a. Work on California Academic Partnership Program (CAPP grant)
  - b. Collaboration of KHSD and BC with CSUB through “Building Bridges” to develop and promote vertical alignment in English
  - c. Work on development and articulation of English course sequence and development of literacy through California Association Teachers of English (CATE)
  - d. Collaboration on AB 86 grant – Adult education
  - e. Baccalaureate of Applied Science (BAS)
  
- 3. Work on Student Planning (8->16->to career)**
  - a. Get FOCUSED – Stay FOCUSED
  - b. Delivery of abbreviated Student Ed Plan (aSEP) to all high school seniors planning to register at BC
  - c. Non-cognitive assessment, development, and teacher training
  - d. Statewide Pathways Collaboration in development and promotion of Career and Technical Education (CTE) – existing articulated courses and beyond
  
- 4. Accountability**
  - a. Data sharing with BC and KHSD for better placement and analysis
  - b. Collecting and analyzing data to promote college readiness – CalPASS
  - c. Analyzing student success in college
  - d. Career data – Salary Surfer(CCCCO) and CTE launchboard (CalPASS)
