Phase I: February 2- February 5

Task Force completes initial work

- Review of current organizational structure, key institutional documents and college-wide initiatives
- Review draft and finalize work plan

Phase 2: February 7 – February 18

Engage in college-wide discussion and identify areas of need

• Conduct targeted focus groups with various college constituencies and multiple collegewide open forums to explain the process, answer questions and gather input
