**Institutional Effectiveness Partnership Initiative (IEPI) March 24, 2015:** On March 24, 2015, BC hosted the IEPI regional workshop at the fireside room. It was a sold out event and we had to limit the size of the BC team<sup>1</sup> who attended. Janet Fulks will be presenting on the IEPI at today's meeting. I am on the IEPI state-wide steering committee as well as chairing one of the six pilot technical training teams called Project Resource Team (PRT) on April 27, 2015.

### **Achieving the Dream March 25, 2015:**

- We had a successful visit from both our leadership coach and our data coach. They wanted us to focus more on "evaluation" both formative and summative. Our data coaches will start working on this aspect right away. In the meantime we will contract with the RP group using funding from SSSP and Equity to help frame the evaluation.
