Completion Data

- Data indicates trend for college but not for the state
- The trends for the entire state were downward we predicted this looking at the data at the state level

Persistence data

 Basically flat and similar to statewide – nothing we can address now

30 Unit rate

 Basically flat and similar to statewide – nothing we can address now




BC Remedial 6-year Rates

- Math Remedial completion rates have improved 2.4% for this cohort in the last 5 years
- That is tremendous!!
- But it is still almost 6% below the state average
- English Remedial completion rate is basically flat for this cohort (later you will see the 3 year cohorts have GREATLY improved)
- It is still 15.5% below statewide averages
- ESL completion rates are increasing AND above state averages


BC three year cohort differences
