COMMITTEE CHARGE	Hears student conduct complaint To hear and determine outcomes of referrals of students who have violated the student code of conduct and/or student complaints that have appeals beyond Level III of the Student Complaint Procedures.
SCOPE OF AUTHORITY	The Hearing Panel shall determine whether or not accused student/s violated the Student Conduct Code section as charged. Student Conduct Hearing Board is established so that students can resolve difficulties/problems which they encounter in College related activities. Student conduct matters are taken seriously. Therefore, the complaint must be of a compelling, substantive, and verifiable nature. If the complaint cannot be resolved at Levels I, II or III, then a Hearing Panel shall be convened to hear the student complaints. The Hearing Panel shall determine whether or not accused student/s violated the Student Conduct Code section as charged. Students found to be in violation of the Student Conduct Code may be recommended for suspensions or expulsion.
