State of the College - This document was reviewed by the Board of Trustees on January 25.

- Report focuses on outcomes; enrollment growth; strong 50%; improved in all student success indicators; budget and productivity are strong; increase in ATDs.
- Not all ATDs were being accepted by CSUB; this is an institutional priority and will be addressed on a variety of levels focusing on student success and collaboration between BC and CSUB faculty.
- Productive Retention & Success Index newly developed and data coaches will continue to incorporate this into the work of the college; will have Bill Moseley and Janet Fulks with small College Council group to present at a future College Council meeting.

Fulks described the writing for the Department of Finance Innovation Award is based on our strategy to implement pathways at BC

- \$2.5 million award directly from state legislature
- Four pillars: Clarify the Path, Enter the Path, Stay on the Path, Ensure Learning
- Ensures a link to workforce or transfer after completion

COLLEGE PROMISE INNOVATION GRANT

Bonds noted that the application describes work we already do at BC, articulated to meet the six required outcomes of the grant:

- ° Increase College Attendance Directly from High School
- ° Increase College-Ready Placement in Math and English at Bakersfield College
- ° Improve Associate's Degree/Certificate Attainment
- Improve Transfer Rates
- ° Improve Associate's Degree/Certificate Attainment
- ° Increase Bachelor's Degree Attainment
- BC Promise focuses on timely completion: a promise to complete within a specific timeframe that ultimately reduces the financial obligation of the student.
- Team is strategizing how best to provide a financial support component.
 - Collaboration among Kern Community Foundation, KEDC Foundation and BC Foundation strategize partners to provide a financial support component President's Scholars, possibly \$100 a semester.
 - ° Other sources include, Levan Center, Title V and Strong Workforce.
- This is a 2-year grant, with one-time funding of \$750, 00 from CCCCO.
- Submission deadline is February 3; will receive notice within one week; BC will begin work quickly once notified.
