### Integrity



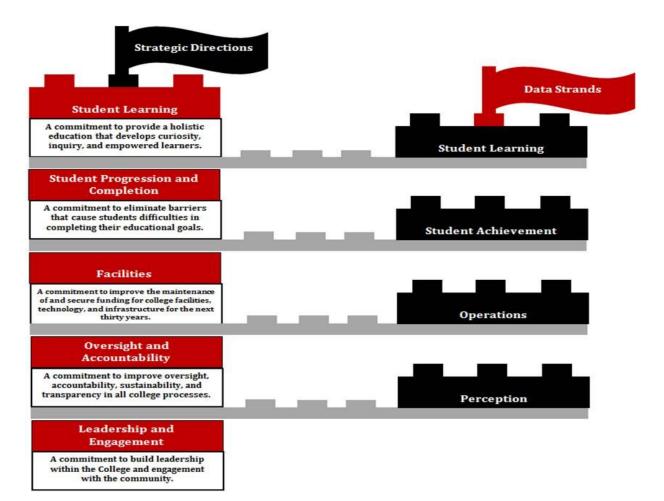
