WHY SET STANDARDS? WHAT ARE THEY?

- ▶ Required by ACCJC (accreditation).
- ▶ Required by the Federal Government.
- ▶ BC began setting standards in 2013 before they were required...because they give us a reference.
- ▶ Standards establish a floor of success regarding student achievement.
- ▶ Provide a common measure across all higher ed institutions.

WHAT STANDARDS ARE REQUIRED?

- ▶ Course Completion
 - ▶ Licensing Exam Pass Rates
 - ▶ Job Placement Rates
 - ▶ Persistence term to term
 - ▶ Degree and certificate completion
 - ▶ Transfer Rates

COURSE COMPLETION

- ▶ Annual
- ▶ Fall
- ▶ Look at 5 years
- ▶ One standard deviation
