

AB 705 Analysis of Pass Rates of Groups of Students in Transfer-level Statistics

AB 705 requires community colleges to optimize students' probability of completing transfer-level math and English within one year. It also prohibits colleges from placing students into a basic skills class that will extend students' time to completing transfer-level math and English unless a student is highly unlikely to succeed in the transfer-level coursework without the basic skills course.
