District Consultation Council

Holmes expressed concern about the proposed Board Policies appearing on the November Trustees agenda when the Chancellor had stated to Consultation Council that they would have the first reading at a work session on November 28.

Vaughn announced that each area should review the proposals carefully once again because there are many errors- items that we agreed upon to be corrected, but have not been corrected, and errors that are contrary to Title 5 regulations.

AB705, Multiple Measures Update

Craig Hayward reported that we are already implementing multiple measures and a redesign of ACDV courses. Now we are working on fine-tuning what we are doing with data the clearly shows that students who are paced below college level are placed because the data show that they are unlikely to succeed in the college level course. One option that we are looking at is to have mandatory co-requisite labs of supplemental instruction for students who barely place into the college level course.
