
# FACILITIES UPDATE

- VRC demolition has begun
  - Groundbreaking was November 5
  - Scheduled for completion in December 2019



# SCIENCE & ENGINEERING BUILDING






- Bernards Bros. Construction selected as the Design-Build team

  - Scheduled for completion in December 2022








## **STADIUM**

  - January 2020-August 2020






# FOOD SERVICES

  - Kitchen moved during Winter Recess
- Food Services now in the Huddle
- Will have BC food truck on campus serving food named "Gades Grub"





# **CAMPUS CENTER**



- Some Campus Center offices moved to LEV in October
  - Student Life, BCSGA, Veterans Resource Center, Health Center
- Demolition of Campus Center began in December 2018
  - Groundbreaking January 16
  - Scheduled for completion in mid-November 2020

# INFRASTRUCTURE

 Will take place over the course of the Measure J project schedules



- Total of nine (9) small projects
  - Campus water pressure and lines
  - Thermal tank
  - EMS system and building meters (water, gas, power)
  - Sewer lines
  - Modifications and repairs to the northeast corner of campus
  - Security cameras/Data/Fiber
  - High voltage electrical
  - Storm Drain
  - Gas lines

# **OTHER PROJECTS**

- Parking lots
  - Close Out Phase (all lots completed)
- Arvin Campus
  - Programming phase
  - Currently performing surveys at the donated land
- Campus Signage
  - Programming phase
  - Installing monument signage on the four corners of Bakersfield College: Haley & University, University & Mount Vernon, Mount Vernon & Panorama
- Swing Space
  - Temporary classroom and office space for programs to use as they are moved for Measure J projects
  - Various phases, but to date have completed projects at LEV, Huddle & MVC
