AACC/AASA College & Career Readiness Convening

On March 24, 2019, Bakersfield College (BC) and McFarland Unified School District (MUSD) leadership traveled to Washington, D.C. to participate in the Convening on College and Career Readiness, hosted by the American Association of Community Colleges (AACC) and The School Superintendents Association (AASA).

AACC and AASA invited BC and MUSD to present on the Early College project and partnership as a scalable best practice to other high schools and colleges regionally, statewide, and nationally.
