Fall 2019 Enrollment:

The September 4, 2019 enrollment update from Institutional Research shows:

- Enrollment at BC for fall 2019 is 6.1% higher than the same time last fall which is a **449.6 FTES increase** this fall over last fall.

Intersegmental Pathways Symposium


On Friday, November 15, Bakersfield College will host an educational symposium on intersegmental pathways to address baccalaureate completion in California. Keynote speakers include Eloy Oakley, California Community Colleges Chancellor, Lande Ajose, Senior Policy Advisor to Gavin Newsom, and Tony Thurmondd, CA Superintendent of Public Instruction. The symposium will include five panels addressing efficiency and effectiveness in educational policy and practice across our systems.



UC Transfer Pathways

Bakersfield College is preparing to launch a project to establish UC Transfer Pathway agreements to baccalaureate completion. In partnership with UC Merced, BC will develop streamlined transfer pathways to align curriculum from BC to the UC with published maps in the Program Pathways Mapper. Leaders from each college will meet in early November to begin development of the work plan. See attached document prepared by Craig Hayward and Lesley Bonds.

Enrollment Management: In 2018-19, 21,015 of all UC enrollees were transfer students, a 25% relative increase in transfer enrollees since 2012-13. However, the overall proportion of enrollees has remained steady at approximately 30% system-wide.



BC Guided Pathways Showcase

On Friday, October 18, the Guided Pathways Implementation Team will host approximately 50 colleagues from California Community Colleges from San Diego to the Central Valley to share about the college's guided pathways implementation and outcomes. Through three breakout sessions, attendees will hear about BC's signature work around transfer pathways, the Program Pathways Mapper, Summer Bridge, meta-majors, Early College, and more.

Educational Systems and Intersegmental Pathways Task Force

The Educational Systems and Intersegmental Pathways Task Force met on September 26th to discuss current projects and advances as well as formulate solutions in that area. During the next year, the group will work to enhance its Finish in Four model and framework for others. The group will have its final meeting in spring 2020.
