

• The mission of the Bakersfield College Rural Initiatives team is to provide ready access to the high quality education that our socially and ethnically diverse rural area residents need in order to thrive in a rapidly changing world. To this end, the Rural Initiatives team is committed to providing quality instruction that supports the completion of baccalaureate, transfer, associate, and certificate programs, as well as academic support services that promote student success throughout rural Kern County. The team recognizes that rural areas are often underrepresented in college attendance and therefore strives to foster a college-going culture through targeted outreach to early college, traditional, and adult learners, as well as cultural and historical enrichment events for rural communities and students.

EARLY COLLEGE

- A sample of the model in action:
 - Shafter HS
 - All incoming freshman in 2019 and beyond will have the opportunity to complete 6+ units.
 - Academic Pathway-Cohort
 - Currently **40 Sophomores** enrolled concurrently (*CRIM B1*)
 - Students can complete **38 General Education** units through Dual and Concurrent Enrollment offerings at their site.
 - City of Shafter coming on as a partner.
 - Arvin HS
 - **Game Changer Grant (2015)** initiated Early College model in Arvin. Complete at least **one year of college** by graduation.
 - Two full time educational advisors dedicated to Arvin HS.
 - Two cohorts in:
 - Over 90 students (Some sophomores with 15 units already)
 - Welcoming cohort 3 this Fall



EARLY COLLEGE

- A sample of the model in action:
 - Wonderful College Prep Academy and Wasco HS (Launch in 2014)
 - WCPA- Two graduating classes
 - Wasco HS- One graduating class
 - Start with cohorts of 60. All grades now covered-Nearly 500 students on track to AS- Ag Business and Ag Mech
