The September 30 enrollment update from Institutional Research shows:

- Enrollment at BC for fall 2020 is 7.7% lower than the same time last fall which is a **601.36 FTES decrease** this fall over last fall.

## **Chancellor Burke Announced Spring 2021 Plans**




