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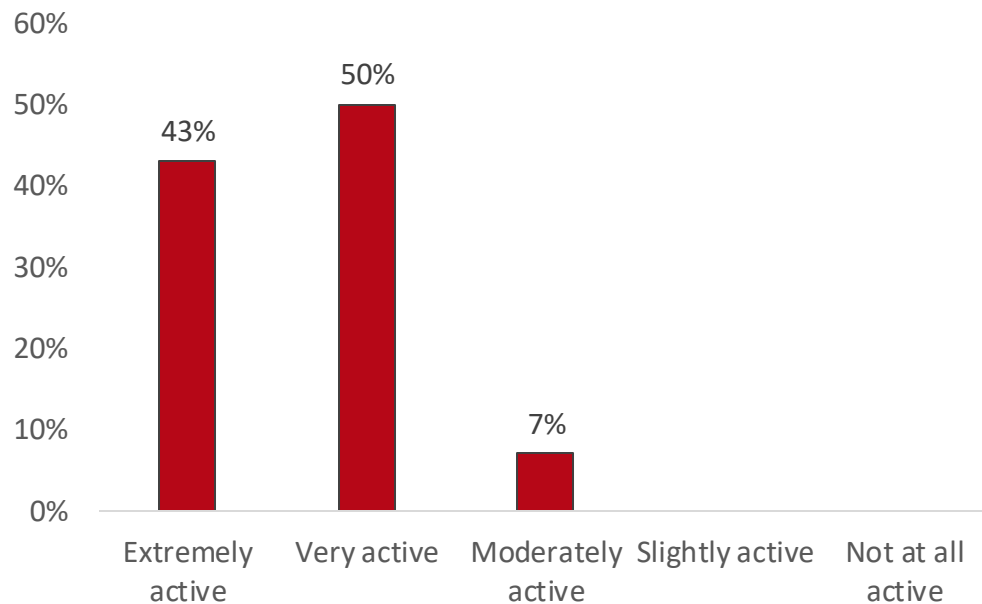
Overall objectives

- Supported by a \$500,000 grant from the California Education Learning Lab & supplemented by \$72,000 grant from the College Futures Foundation

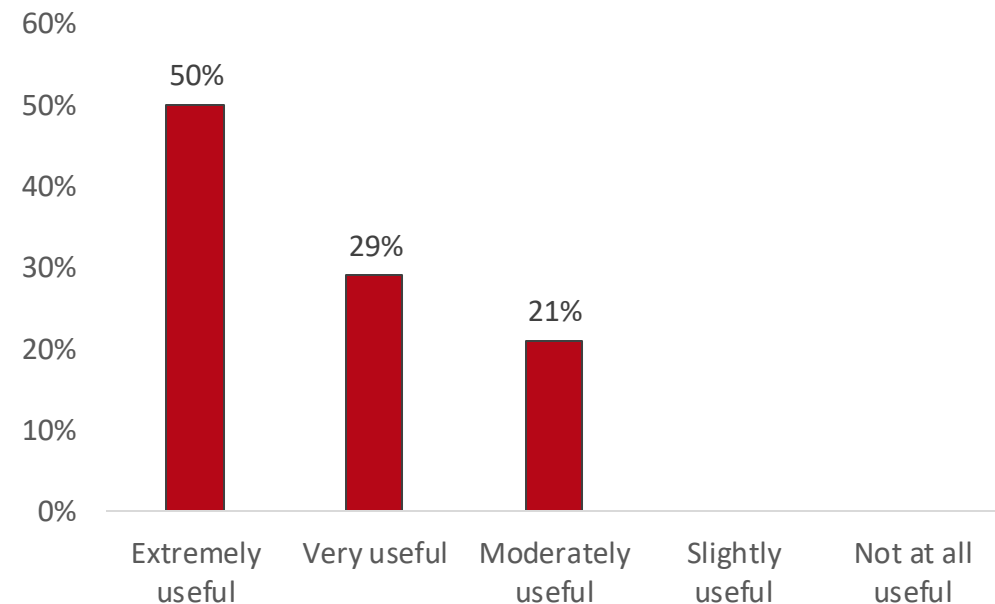
Convening #1
