SGA President Edith Mata will schedule a time to speak to Academic Senate. ○ We will only get back to normal if people feel safe. ● Enrollment Update <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ FTES Recomputed – Revised 320 report, FTS went up 3.6% for BC in fiscal year 2021, important in terms of our funding but also our internal budget allocation model—we are now over 75% of the district FTES! But our numbers are going down. ○ Spring Enrollment Mix – Focusing on adjusting our enrollment to reflect what the student demand is, starting now! Monitor and pay attention. ○ Adult Education – Adult students who have been underemployed or unemployed=how do we facilitate them coming back into the workplace/scale up our focus to help them?
