The \$2.1 Million of additional budget came from contigency (\$1M) and savings from the Administrative ServicesBuilding (\$1.1M). The extra work has extended the project schedule by eight months which had cost impacts. Occupancy is -\$2,100,000 sheduled for December 2022.
