Announcements:

- EMC voted at its most recent meeting on April 23 to request further information to clarify policies, procedures, and past practices of priority registration which include, but are not limited to, revisions of student groups assigned priority registration and coding of students assigned priority registration. The motion specified that the EMC Co-Chairs were to request further information from their respective constituency contacts (Academic Senate President, VPI, and BC/District CSEA President).  - Title 5 §§ 58106 and 58108
- EMC reviewed a draft of scheduling considerations related to some of the goals of the committee, such as offering department-specific Strategic Enrollment Management (SEM) support and enhancing SEM with scheduling efficiency. This draft of scheduling considerations may eventually serve as a reference when a department/discipline schedules courses. These scheduling considerations are designed to form a living document that can change over time to meet institutional needs.
