 - 900+ classes, 300 out of compliance; 100 not yet renewed; ~ 100 more coming= lots of work
 - Outside help from honorary members later; no technical help yet (hope for hire?)

• Sue G.-D. Update

- End of May Chancellor SB1440 Bill
 - 2013=80% of top 25 majors must be in compliance (have AS/AST in place)
 - We have about 4 of the 25 in compliance
 - 2014=100% of top 25 majors must be in compliance
 - Assessment for transfer workshop=Studio Art at board State Chancellor
 - Degrees well on their way in Fall: Math, Geology, Physics
 - Others: Kinesiology, Administration/Criminal Justice

o C-ID website

- Check to see if our courses and course descriptors match
 - If aligned, makes easier the push through (puts more on fast track)
 - Can accept pre-reqs. for UC's if higher than a CSU for bare minimums
 - Rejects occur with incomplete, no detail or critical thinking skills detailed in descriptors (info from Ono)

- Vetting takes a long time
- CSUs impacted, only wanting students with AA or AST for transfer for spring
- Stand Alone Course Training from Chancellor's office
 - Achievement degrees=24 units (minimum)
 - Stand Alone Certificate must be less than 18 semester units
 - More than 18 semester units=degree program
 - AB1943=Locally approved Stand Alones
 - Must be approved before taught=very few
 - Electronically submitted
 - Course must get ID number to report to state
 - Technical Review stuff:
 - Have to be appropriate to mission, need, standards, etc.
 - o Same rigor
 - o 48 Hours of Student study on own time
 - If denied by Chancellor's office, must be MODIFIED
 - Courses are open to anyone
 - Math, reading, etc.
 - No pre-regs. needed, but can be a pre-reg. for another course
 - Question: Can still be offered at Community College?
 - May be gone as of January 2013
 - If not part of program, these courses will be cut or provided as part of community education.
 - Question (Dan O.): What about Geography? No degree; is it stand alone?
 - o No, is part of Gen. Ed. & the Liberal Arts Degree
 - Question: What about 1st Aid?
 - Attached to kinesiology now
 - Question: Who takes these classes?
 - o Folks who need for jobs
 - Students preparing for success, basic skills
