| MEMBERSHIP | The CC GE Workgroup is chaired by the Vice President of Academic Affairs, or designee, and one Curriculum Committee Faculty CoChair. <br> - GE Team members (including AO and Transfer Director) <br> - Assessment Co-Chair or designee <br> - 1 Curriculum Committee representative from each of the following 'divisions of learning': <br> - Natural Sciences (This category would include introductory or integrative courses in astronomy, biology, chemistry, general physical science, geology, meteorology, oceanography, physical geography, physical anthropology, physics and other scientific disciplines.) <br> - Social and Behavioral Sciences (This category would include introductory or integrative survey courses in cultural anthropology, cultural geography, economics, history, political science, psychology, sociology and related disciplines.) <br> - Humanities (Such courses could include introductory or integrative courses in the arts, foreign languages, literature, philosophy, and religion.) <br> - Language and Rationality (one from each division of learning below) <br> - English Composition (English and English as a Second Language.) <br> - Communication and Analytical Thinking (oral communication, mathematics, and quantitative reasoning such as logic, statistics, computer languages and programming, and related disciplines) <br> - Health and Wellness (district requirement) |
| DECISION MAKING PROCESS | Quorum shall be the nearest whole number greater than half the number of confirmed voting members. Vacant positions shall not be counted to determine quorum. All members, including co-chairs, have voting privileges. Decisions will be made using a majority of total filled positions. |
