Dual Enrollment and Catalog Rights: From the CSU Chancellor's Office, CSU catalog rights are outlined in <u>Section 40401</u>. *The term "first-time freshman" means an applicant who has earned college credit not later than the end of the summer immediately following high school graduation or an applicant who has not earned any college credit.* Students intending to transfer to UCs should consider the <u>UC Transfer</u> <u>Maximum Credit Limitation Policy</u>.

OER and C-ID: Many courses taught at the California Community Colleges are aligned to C-ID (<u>Course</u> <u>Identification Numbering System</u>) descriptors that have been developed intersegmentally. As of 2018, <u>C-</u> <u>ID descriptor forms</u> have specifically encouraged consideration of Open Educational Resources (OER), demonstrating the general acceptance of OER.

OER info from CSU and UC: Open Educational Resources (OER) are acceptable submissions as long as they're stable and publicly available as published textbooks. They should not be just a collection of links to lecture notes or webpages.

ASCCC Fall 2021 Plenary Resolutions: Please review the resolutions. Section 4 and 9 pertain to Articulation, Transfer, and Curriculum. If you have any questions or feedback, please work with our BC ASCCC Delegate, Lisa Harding.

Disciplines List Hearing: Friday, November 5th from 8:00am to 9:00am. Review the <u>CCC Confer</u> <u>Participant Instructions</u> to join the Zoom meeting. The Disciplines List Revision Proposals include <u>Asian</u> <u>American Studies</u>*, <u>Native American-Indian Studies</u>*, <u>Nanotechnology Studies</u>, and <u>Geographic</u> <u>Information Systems</u>. *(2) identical proposals were received for Asian American Studies and Native American Studies so we are providing the proposal that provides the additional back-up documentation. More resource materials are available on the <u>Disciplines List Webpage</u>.

Credit for Prior Learning and CSUs: The <u>CSU policy on Credit for Prior Learning</u> as revisions to the previous EO1036 is now finalized. Important features of the new policy include: Applicability to both undergraduate and graduate credit, Separate section for military-affiliated students, Clear indication that previously transcribed CPL by the CCC shall be accepted for transfer.
