## Articulation Officer Report

**AB 928:** ASCCC is still accepting input on AB 928 online. <u>Submit Input.</u> AB 928 Draft from <u>ICAS</u> coming by May 2022 in order to provide time for vetting through the three systems which needs to be done by May 2023.

**ASSIST:** Review articulation agreements in ASSIST and check if anything is missing.

**AB 1705**: "Clean Up Language" on AB 705 was introduced at the end of January. Read the evolving <u>AB 1705 text</u>.

**AB 1111:** SOVA workgroup evaluating AB 1111 work and implications.

**Prerequisites and Articulation**: With the AB 705 Improvement Plan and the AB 1705 proposal, prerequisite language may need adjustments. Prerequisites required by C-ID, UC transferability, CSU GE, or IGETC should not be removed. Specific courses may not be needed. Changes to prerequisites will require external re-evaluation. Possible resolution coming for Spring 2022 Plenary urging collaboration between C-ID, CSU, and UC systems in order provide guidance.

**CLEP, IB, AP**: <u>CCCCO Memo ESS 22-200-003</u> was sent out in February. The catalog pages for CLEP, IB, and AP are being updated in collaboration with the Department Chairs to verify information.

**IGETC Updates:** Academic Senate of UC released a memo (<u>Re: Assembly Approval of Revision to</u> <u>Senate Regulation 478</u>) on February 9<sup>th</sup> explaining upcoming new IGETC Area 7 Guidelines and requirements. The change involves reducing the number of required courses for IGETC Area 4 (Social and Behavioral Sciences) from 3 to 2 in order to accommodate a new Area 7 course without increasing the overall IGETC course total and to better align with CSU's plans. The changes will probably be applied to the next IGETC review cycle, which begins in December 2022 for academic year 2023-24. No information on Catalog Rights yet.
