## College Level Examination Program (CLEP)

The <u>College Level Examination Program (CLEP)</u> is a means through which academic credit may be given for nontraditional forms of educational experience. Those who may have reached a college level of education through home or correspondence study, on-the-job training, television courses, military service, or other means may take the CLEP examinations which are offered by the College Entrance Examination Board through the Bakersfield College <u>Testing and Placement Center</u>.

Subject examinations are articulated to specific courses listed below. With a passing score on one CLEP exam or more, you may submit a *Request for Evaluation form* to Admissions and Records in the Administration building, Room 7, after you are enrolled in classes at Bakersfield College. A maximum of 30 units of credit by examination may be applied toward an associate degree and/or general education at Bakersfield College.
