Bakersfield College recognizes the high scholastic quality of the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program and awards credit or placement as approved. Students who plan to enroll at Bakersfield College, submit a copy of your official IB transcript to the Office of Admissions and Records in the Administration building, room 7, for evaluation.

Units for which credit is given pursuant to these examinations will not be counted in determining the 12 semester units in residence required for an associate degree.

Advanced Placement score of 3, 4, or 5 is required for general education certification.
