Military Credit

Bakersfield College will grant veterans 12 elective credits for military service. Review of Joint Service Transcript (JST) will be made by the Office of Admissions and Records based on the determination of discipline faculty. Credit evaluations will conform to the regulations set forth by the State Approval Agency of the California State Department of Education and the recommendations of the American Council on Education.

A Veteran student who has successfully completed Basic Military Training/Recruit Training, with any character discharge, excluding dishonorable, will be awarded 12 semester units as listed below:

- HLEDB1 (3 Units)
- Physical Education (2 Units)
- and General Education (7 Units)
- Bakersfield College GE Area E1 / CSU GE Area E (3 units)
- Bakersfield College GE Area E2 (1 unit)
- Articulate courses between JST/transcripts with Bakersfield College Catalog
 - o Articulated courses have no maximum unit application
 - In the event courses cannot be articulated, remaining units to be applied as General Elective(s) to bring the total amount of units awarded to 12

Submission of an official copy of the veteran's Joint Service Transcript (JST) or transcripts from the Community College of the Air Force to Admissions and Records is required.

Military credit granted by Bakersfield College is currently accepted only by the CSU system may be reviewed by transfer institutions. Military credit evaluations may take up to 24 weeks once the Office of Admissions and Records receives your official Joint Service Transcript (JST).

Students need to submit a <u>Request for Evaluation Form</u> to <u>BCrecords@kccd.edu</u> from their Bakersfield College assigned email account to start the process for evaluations.
