AB 1111 (Common Course Numbering) Update

The ASCCC submitted the CCN templates to the CCC Chancellor's Office by the August 15th deadline. The CCC Chancellor's Office has received and reviewed these templates and added the CCN subject number and identifier in preparation for their release. The CCC Chancellor's Office is now sharing the templates with the CSU and UC systems, and each segment is conducting its own review of the templates to determine UC transferability and GE approvals.

The CCC Chancellor's Office is designating a series of memos and webinars in September to address various CCN-related topics. The first webinar is scheduled for September 4th, with a focus on curriculum. To facilitate this, it is our hope that the Chancellor's Office will make templates available to all stakeholders by that time.

General Education and Articulation Updates

Department Chairs, Deans, and Curriculum representatives were emailed with the results of the IGETC and CSU GE Fall 2024 starts. All future submissions will either request Cal-GETC and/or BC GE (starting Summer 2025) options. Please do not remove CSU GE, IGETC or old BC GE (ending Spring 2025) options for historical purposes and we transition.

All ADT programs will need to be revised to include Cal-GETC requirements.

All transferable local degrees will need to be revised to include Cal-GETC requirements. For CTE programs, this may mean resubmission to external bodies such as advisory meetings and regional consortium approval.
