

What is Early College?



• Opportunities for high school students to earn college credits through a combination of dual and concurrent enrollment courses.



Early College Levels of Implementation

Level 1: Exploration

The high school students can complete college courses on site through a combination of dual enrollment and concurrent enrollment offered on the high school campus.

Level 2: Installation

Level 3: Implementation

All incoming ninth grade students are on a pathway to earn between 9 and 60 units towards completing a college degree and/or certificate through a combination of dual enrollment and concurrent enrollment courses offered on the high school campus.


