

# OTHER STATES' RESULTS



#### REMEDIATION REFORM ACROSS THE USA

- 2014 Florida law bans prerequisite remediation placement
- 2014 West Virginia starts system-wide co-reqs (x2 to x4 improvement)
- 2015 Tennessee institutes co-req remediation (x2 to x4 improvement)
- 2015 Colorado, Georgia, Indiana start system-wide co-req remediation
- 2016 California Basic Skills Outcomes and Transformation Grant
- 2017 Texas law passed that bans prerequisite remediation placement 2018
- 2017 California Assembly votes unanimously for AB 705 start Fall 2019



## BC AB705 PLACEMENT:

- The College is working on details for Fall 2019.
- AB 705: all students will be placed into transfer-level with or without a required co-requisite laboratory unless..
  - data shows that they will succeed at a higher rate in 2 semesters if placed
     1-level below transfer and
  - that they will be "highly unlikely to succeed" in a transfer-level course.




