During the month of October, The ITT Pathway work moved forward at a slower pace than I had hoped for, but it did move. We have completed our team build out and received a multi-year commitment from faculty that agreed to be on this team. This is critical for a team to be able to start identifying weak points in the pathway and start to build a path for correction. Having long standing members was a personal goal of mine that can complete meaningful work without having to go through this process year after year losing more than a fourth ¼ of our time building a team.

Now that our team is built, we have started to identify areas of immediate attention. We felt a strong need to identify Acute matter first then work on the Chronic issue second. Below you will find a list of our team which can be changed from time to time as faculty and staff change responsibilities or make a choice to leave BC for other employment. In those cases, we will seek the immediate replacement. There is also a list showing the Acute issues we have identified, and this can be changed to a Chronic issue if it is not immediately rectifiable. Team members will be assigned to work on these issues, and we will be steady in the work until it is accomplished. Our team will not take on more than what is accomplishable at any given time. As one issue is resolved we will add additional issue and assign them to the appropriate person with the skill set or ability to work with the team on a resolution.

As the team lead, I will continue to keep the team focused and continue to track all activity within the assigned matters for each member. I will also be focusing on data results and keeping up with the team's information to report data. We are not looking for huge leaps, but rather small steps and we will get to our goal one step at a time.
