## Monthly Report AHC Pathway Completion Community December 2019

## What we have done

- Helen Acosta has been working with the Public Relations department to move forward with the AHC Pathways brochures
- We have come to a final resolution regarding some departments whose membership was unclear. It has been decided that philosophy is part of the Arts, Humanities, Communication Pathway and history is part of the Social and Behavioral Sciences. The data has been corrected to reflect these department's memberships.
- Jonathan Schultz, our AHC Pathway counselor, has been sending Pathways-informed emails to our students corresponding with the messages for each semester week.
- We have asked Amber Hroch to investigate any relationship between financial aid's changes in disbursements—from 3 disbursements to 2 given by census—and student success rates. This was done last meeting, but I will submit an official request at the start of next semester.
